



## REMEMBER

St. Stephen is a private, CATHOLIC SCHOOL. Please be familiar with the following school requirements:

1. Let your child know that you believe in obedience, respect, and good behavior,
2. Show a committed interest in the work your child talks about and brings home.
3. Check for completeness and quality of homework daily.
4. Participate in school-related activities. Your time and effort sends a strong message to your child.
5. If your child is disciplined by a teacher or the school administration, understand that your child's version has been filtered through the mind and experience of a child. The reliability of children to interpret and understand at an adult level is highly questionable; that's why we have parents and teachers to help in their growth and formation. If you have a question regarding an incident, go to the source for more information – teacher and/or principal – not other parents. The school should be a training ground in cooperation for students, not an arena for conflict.
6. Maintain a charitable attitude to those in our school community.
7. Responsibility at home fosters responsibility at school.
