We have a few EXTREMELY important reminders. Your attention to these matters is greatly appreciated.

- 1. The morning bell rings at 7:40 AM.
- 2. ALL STUDENTS in Grades K-8 should be here <u>before</u> the 7:40 AM bell rings and enter the school through the Caroline St. doors <u>with their classes</u>. We have too many students arriving late and entering through the front door. This is disruptive to the office as well as their classrooms.
- 3. Rectory Driveway: Under NO CIRCUMSTANCE should any Parent/Guardian or family member pull in, park, or sit and wait in this driveway in the morning or at dismissal. This is a private driveway and the home to Clergy Members.
- 4. Please DO NOT stop cars at the end of Arthur St., Caroline St, or in any private driveways or crosswalks and leave your vehicle to cross children, or sit and watch children come into the building. Please find a legal place to park.

APRIL VALUE OF THE MONTH CONSERVATION

Conservation can be a difficult concept for children to understand. Teaching them to reduce waste and use less of our natural resources can be tricky. When explaining conservation to children, use simple terms that relate to their daily lives. Define resources as things we need such as energy and clean water, and explain that resources are hard to replace once we have used them. Relate conservation to saving something for later by having them imagine a bag of candy; if they ate all the candy at once, they wouldn't have any to eat later. Gentle reminders from positive role models will help children imitate eco-friendly behavior.


If you wish to change your payment plan, please contact Mrs. Kneeland at the school. Changes to bank account numbers or credit card numbers can be made on line.

Re-registration Forms for 2018-19

All current students need to re-register for the upcoming school year. We want to remind parents that the registration fee is now \$175.00.

If your child will not be returning next year, please indicate that on the re-registration form and return it to the school office as soon as possible. All financial obligations to St. Stephen School must be satisfied prior to a student's transfer. Please note that any parish school and diocesan high school will not accept incoming students from parish schools whose financial obligations are incomplete.

2018/2019 TUITION DEPOSIT OF \$300 (per child) is due May 1st.
